

VALBELLUNA, MONTE AVENA AND DOLADA

Located at the gateway of the **Dolomiti Bellunesi National Park**, Monte Avena is a natural, open-air playground perfect for hang gliding and paragliding. The mountain rises high above the medieval town of **Feltre** and offers breath taking views over **Valbelluna**. Get a bird's eye view of the immense mountainous amphitheatre of **Alpago**, with its deep green forests, mountain meadows, alpine huts, and **Lago di Santa Croce**. Take-off from the slopes of **Monte Dolada**, the perfect site to begin your vacation, whether you're flying alone or in tandem.

VALSUGANA

At **Vetriolo Terme** in Valsugana, the 2000+ meters of **Cima Panarotta** offer a fantastic view of the Brenta Dolomites, the Lagorai range, Valsugana, and the sparkling waters of **Lago di Caldonazzo** and **Lago di Levico**. This location has excellent possibilities for hang gliding, paragliding and cross country flying, even during less favourable months of the year.

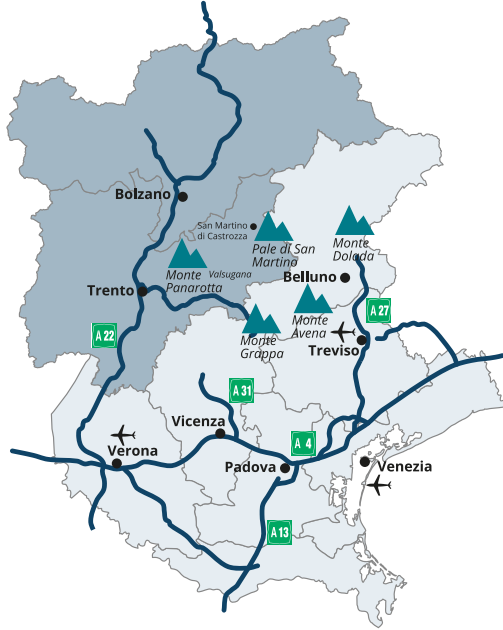
PALE DI SAN MARTINO

The **Pale di San Martino** – the most extensive mountain massif in the Dolomites – the wild and remote **Lagorai** range, and the **Vette Feltrine**, frame the valleys of Primiero and Vanoi, ideal sites for flying solo or tandem in the heart of the **Paneveggio Pale di San Martino Natural Park**.



THE MONTE GRAPPA MASSIF

Monte Grappa is a perfect location for beginners and for **cross country** flying, thanks to its strategic location in the **foothills of the Dolomites**. Uncontaminated **nature** characterises this site for hang gliding and paragliding, making it ideal for outdoor sports more generally. **History**, culture, **art**, and tradition add fascinating layers to this area's many attractions.

15TH FAI PARAGLIDING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

In 2017, the skies over Feltre became the theatre for the world paragliding championship, hosting hundreds of athletes from the around the world – an international event that consecrated Monte Avena as a prime global destination for hang gliding and paragliding.

And for non-fliers?

Hotels and wellness centres, trekking, vie ferrate, interpreted walking tours on the theme of the Great War, excursions by road or mountain bike (enduro, downhill, pump track), rock climbing, sailing, wind and kite surfing, canyoning, canoeing, and water skiing. 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MONTE AVENA TAKE-OFF SITES

Monte Avena zone A (1417 m)

Wind direction south / south-east • Landing field over 11,500 m² • accessible to 120 hang gliders or 200 paragliders • two windows for take-off

Monte Avena zone B (1438 m)

Wind direction south / south-west • accessible to 50-60 pilots

LANDING SITES

Boscherai (350 m)

20,000 m² landing zone • obstacle free for any wind condition • restrooms, parking and camper area for competitions

Arten

6000 m² landing zone • east-west orientation windsock • large escape margin

MONTE DOLADA TAKE-OFF SITES

Rifugio Dolada (1500 m)

Wind direction south • near Rifugio Dolada Perfect for experts and non-experts

LANDING SITES

Garna (600 m)

Camper area and campground equipped with showers and services • large parking lot • multifunctional meeting hall • shuttle for take-off site

MONTE PANAROTTA TAKE-OFF SITES

Vetriolo (1500 m)

Wind direction south-west • parking restaurant • hotel and spa • year around flying flights for tourists and long-distance flying

Panarotta (2000 m)

Wind direction south-west • for expert pilots Parking 20 minutes away

LANDING SITES

Levico Terme

South of Levico Terme • 113 m long landing zone Wind direction east/west • restaurant Outdoor green area • posts for campers managed by restaurant

Barco di Levico

Adapted to schools • hang gliding good for beginners east-west orientation • tandem flights in winter allow for coasting along the slopes until you reach the landing zone

Services

- In summer, public transportation service by bus from Barco or Levico central station in morning and afternoon
- Paragliding school

Wind direction west / south-west • food and drink summer only

Wind direction south / south-west • parking, food and drink

Panettone (1550 m) Monte Meda - Cima Grappa

Wind direction east / south-east / west • parking

Col Campeggia (1080 m) Col Campeggia

Wind direction south / south-east • parking Reserved for large events

Antenne (750 m) Costalunga

Wind direction east • parking

PRIMIERO TAKE-OFF SITES

Val Canali – Loc. Tais (1250 m)

Southern exposure • prevalence of dynamic flying, cross-country flying, flying over the Dolomites • food and drink in Val Canali • Accessible by car on paved roads

LANDING SITES

Fiera di Primiero (750 m)

Difficulty: beginner/intermediate • valley winds south-west • Landing zone on private property

SAN MARTINO DI CASTROZZA TAKE-OFF SITE

Alpe Tognola (2170 m)

South-eastern exposure • difficulty: intermediate/expert • Thermal flying, cross-country flying, flying over the Dolomites • alpine hut near take-off site

LANDING SITE

San Martino di Castrozza (1450 m)

Valley winds south-east • Helicopter landing pad in landing zone (Prà delle Nasse) • bar and restaurant in landing zone (Prà delle Nasse)

Services

- Area for professionals and tandem flying
- Nearby alpine huts and food and drink near take-off and landing zones
- NCC transportation
